



1st Grade TEKS Curriculum Applications

The George Ranch Historical Park offers multi-era educational programming that touches upon the major themes of Texas history between the 1820s and the 1940s. Grade 1 TEKS guidelines apply for programs as follows. (This is a general overview, contact us for specific questions about curriculum application during your field trip).

113.3. Social Studies

History 1.1 (A & C) "Students understand how historical figures helped to shape our community, state and nation."

Students learn about early Texans like Stephen F. Austin at the Jones Stock Farm. Σ At each historical era, students learn how prominent and famous Texans impacted our history.

History 1.2 (A, B & C) "Students understand the origins of customs, holidays and celebrations."

Students learn about how people, over time, have celebrated Texas Independence Day, July 4th and other prominent historical holidays.

History 1.3 (A & C) "Students understand the concepts of time and chronology."

Student visitors to the George Ranch see Texas history evolve through three separate and distinctive eras (1820s-30s, 1880s-90s and 1930s).

Geography 1.5 (B) "Students are expected to be able to locate places of significance on community and Texas maps."

Historical programming at the George Ranch Historical Park encourages students to understand how modern geography is both similar to and different from the landscape our forebears encountered.

Geography 1.6 (A, B & C) "Students understand various physical and human characteristics of the environment."

Students learn how people have adapted to and shaped the environment along the Texas Gulf Coast since the 1820s.

Citizenship 1.13 (A, B & D) "Students understand important customs, symbols, and celebrations that represent American beliefs and principles and contribute to our national identity."

Students learn the history and custom behind images like the Lone Star, the Alamo, the Texas longhorn, and more.
